

Are you interested in Directing a show for Morpheus Theatre?

Morpheus Theatre invites directors to make proposals for shows to be produced during our **2010/2011 and 2011/2012** seasons. We encourage experienced and passionate directors to submit a letter of interest along with a resume with related theatre experience and background.

Morpheus produces four quality shows each year (a farce or comedy, a pantomime, a contemporary drama, and a Gilbert & Sullivan operetta) on a variety of stages (Victor Mitchell & Joyce Doolittle Theatres at the Pumphouse; and the Easterbrook Theatre at the Community Arts Centre). Because of the need to raise money for a new rehearsal space, we are looking for **WELL-KNOWN SHOWS with HIGH AUDIENCE POTENTIAL**. Ideally, the shows will appeal to a wide family audience (primarily 12 and up, although under 18 is not the target audience).

Proposals should include the following information:

- * Name of director
- * Directing and theatre related experience
- * Name of show
- * Playwright of show
- * Cast size of show, with male/female ratio
- * Why you think Morpheus should produce it
- * Director's Vision for the show (including overall thoughts about how the show would be staged and any special effects, set ideas, costume ideas, technical considerations)
- * Which theatre it would work best in
- * Potential challenges
- * Any other comments or considerations

At this time, we ask that you don't try to recruit production crew or check on the production rights.
